LAWNS AND ORNAMENTAL TUFF GRASSES Security Crabgrass Killer will control the weeds listed with little or no injury to well established, actively growing turf grasses. Mow turfgrass to a height of 1 to 1 1/2 inches before treatment. Mix 4 fluid ounces of Security Crabgrass Killer with 1 gallon of water and apply to an area of 1,000 square feet. Application should be uniform and thorough, and should include undesirable plants. Two or three repeat treatments at 14-day intervals may be necessary. Make applications during warm weather when temperatures are above 60°F. Do not water for at least 24 hours after application. Turfgrasses may be fertilized during the growing season. Bluegrass and zoysia grasses are quite tolerant to applications. Do not mow lawns for at least 3 days after three mowings. Do not apply to bentgrass and fescues. Do not apply to St. Augustine, carpetgrass, centipedegrass or to any other grasses until 2 weeks after last application.

GENERAL WEED CONTROL Security Crabgrass Killer is very effective in controlling the weeds listed along fences and walls, around the banks around storage houses and near other crop areas. Application should be made after weeds are small and actively growing. Mix at the rate of 1 ounce per gallon of water. Spray undesirable weeds thoroughly to point of run-off. Adequate coverage and moisture wetting is important for effective control. Repeat application may be necessary if weeds reappear.
