

HOW TO USE: Apply with hand trigger sprayer. Sprayer nozzle should be adjusted to allow a coarse spray for applying to cover area occupied by unwanted weeds or grasses. Hold sprayer close to weed (1 to 2 feet) with spray nozzle aimed at weed and away from face. Spray to cover center of weed. Do not overspray. One application will control most weeds listed. If certain tough weeds (e.g. Bermudagrass, Canada thistle or field bindweed) are not completely controlled within 4 weeks, repeat application. This product is a nonselective weed killer and will kill all vegetation contacted. Treated areas in lawns can be reseeded 7 days after application.

IMPORTANT: Security™ Blot-Out Ready-To-Use Weed & Grass Killer will kill most green vegetation. Be careful when treating weeds not to spray or allow spray drift to reach surrounding desirable grasses or nearby plants as they will also be killed. Do not apply when rainfall is expected within 24 hours of application as weed control will be reduced. If spray accidentally contacts desirable foliage, wash off immediately with water.

TO REFILL: Add 2 ounces of Security™ Blot-Out Systemic Weed & Grass Killer to the empty container and add 18 ounces of water to make a 0.5% spray solution. Use according to above directions.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Avoid contamination of feed and food. When empty container is discarded, wrap container and put in trash collection. Keep from freezing.

Visible effects usually occur within 1 week of most weeds with complete kill in 2 to 4 weeks. Best results are obtained when applied to actively growing weeds during warm, sunny weather.
