

**DILUTION**  
**TO MAKE 2 1/2 GALLONS:** Mix 1 quart Baracide to 2 1/2 gallons of water and apply to 125 sq. ft. for GROUP 1 WEEDS, TO 62.5 sq. ft. for GROUP 2 WEEDS or to 250 sq. ft. for RETREATMENT.  
**TO MAKE 5 GALLONS:** Mix 2 quarts Baracide to 4 1/2 gallons of water and apply to 250 sq. ft. for GROUP 1 WEEDS, to 125 sq. ft. for GROUP 2 WEEDS or to 1,000 sq. ft. for RETREATMENT.  
**TO MAKE 10 GALLONS:** Mix 1 gallon Baracide to 9 gallons of water and apply to 500 sq. ft. for GROUP 1 WEEDS, to 250 sq. ft. for GROUP 2 WEEDS or to 1,000 sq. ft. for RETREATMENT.  
**TO MAKE 100 GALLONS:** Mix 10 gallons Baracide to 90 gallons of water and apply to 5,000 sq. ft. for GROUP 1 WEEDS, to 2,500 sq. ft. for GROUP 2 WEEDS or to 10,000 sq. ft. for RETREATMENT.  
**GROUP 1 WEEDS:** Perennial weeds and grasses such as smooth brome, Bahiagrass, Bluegrass, redtop, purpletop, quackgrass, broomsedge, fescue, St. Augustine, centipede, ryegrass, zoysia, aster, dogfennel, goldenrod, plantain, dandelion, wild carrot, and woody brush such as oak, willow, sweet gum and pine.  
**GROUP 2 WEEDS:** Johnsongrass and hard-to-kill deep-rooted perennial weeds and grasses such as bermudagrass, dallisgrass, nutsedge, vaseygrass, saltgrass, bouncingbet, dogbone, bracken fern, horsetail and woody brush such as American elm, winged elm, hackberry, sumac and cottonwood.  
**RETREATMENT:** It requires only one-half the regular rate when retreating existing sites. Use the rates stated in the chart for retreating when annual weeds and grasses reappear on sites where growth has been controlled.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and place in trash collection.

**GENERAL INFORMATION:** Security® Baracide Total Vegetation Killer is a semi-soil sterilant designed to kill existing vegetation and prevent plant growth for up to a year after treatment. Effects of Baracide treatment are slow to appear and may not become apparent until the chemical has been carried into the root zone of the weeds by moisture. Baracide should be applied only to those areas where no plant growth is desired such as driveways, brick walks, gravel pathways, patios, parking areas along fences, curbs and gutters, and cracks in sidewalks. Security® Baracide does not produce harmful vapors or fumes which might harm desirable plants.

**IMPORTANT:** To avoid damage to desirable plants, DO NOT treat areas over the root system of desirable trees and shrubs. Stay beyond the drip line of desirable ornamentals. DO NOT USE on lawns, flowers or vegetable gardens. Apply only when air is calm. Avoid spray drift to desirable plants.

**WHEN TO APPLY:** For barren soil and to prevent plant growth, Security® Baracide Total Vegetation Killer can be applied anytime, but for best results, apply to bare ground or when growth is just starting in the spring. If dense growth is present, best results can be obtained if vegetation is removed before treatment. Do not apply to frozen ground.

**HOW TO APPLY:** Shake well before using. Apply Security® Baracide with a sprinkling can or similar applicator. If soil is dry, irrigate before treatment. Follow chart for proper rates and size of area to be treated. Cover the area to be treated thoroughly. Two or three days after application, water the treated areas heavily, but not to the point of runoff. This will allow the chemical to be washed into the root zone for better kill. **FOR USE PRIOR TO PAVING:** To prevent growth of weeds under asphalt driveways, tennis courts, parking lots and similar areas, apply Security® Baracide to excavated areas to saturate or drench before surface areas are paved.
