DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SECURITY CAPTAN-MOLY 2X is designed especially for treating soybean seed on the farm at planting time. When used at the recommended rate, it will result in increased deposit of chemical on the seed with all types of planters, including air planters, plateless planters and plate planters, except the International Harvester Cyclo Planter.

SECURITY CAPTAN-MOLY 2X protects sound and/or mechanically injured seed against seed and soil borne diseases which may cause seed rot and seedling blight at planting time. It also provides molybdenum which is essential to the nitrogen-fixing nodule bacteria.

Designed to protect seed at planting time, SECURITY CAPTAN-MOLY 2X enables the farmer to avoid the additional handling of commercial seed treatment with its associated injury to seed. Soybeans are most likely to benefit from treatment with this product when planted in acidic soils (soils needing lime), heavily leached soils or soils high in iron content.

MEASURING CUP (4 oz.) ENCLOSED: 1 CUPFUL WILL TREAT 2 BUSHELS OF SEED.

SOYBEANS: Use as a planter box treatment at the rate of 3-1/3 oz. per 100 lbs. seed (2 oz. per bushel). When seed is planted at the rate of one bushel per acre, this will provide the needed 1/2 oz. of sodium molybdate per acre.

To achieve adequate coverage, fill planter box only half full of seed, add one-half the required amount of SECURITY CAPTAN-MOLY 2X and mix thoroughly with a stick. Then add the remainder of the seed in the planter box and add the rest of the required amount of product, again mixing thoroughly. Better results are obtained by premixing seed with SECURITY CAPTAN-MOLY 2X in a suitable container, then pouring treated seed into planter box. Treated seed must not be used for or mixed with food or animal feed, or processed for oil. Do not feed forage grown from treated seed. Seed commercially treated with this product must be labeled in accordance with all applicable requirements of the Federal Seed Act.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store pesticide in original container and place in a locked storage area. Opened pesticide containers should be securely resealed prior to storage. Protect from penetration of moisture, excessive heat or cold. Avoid cross-contamination with other pesticides or fertilizers. Use caution when storing pesticides in stacks.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of federal law.
