

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes and skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Remove birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Avoid spraying food or foodstuffs. Do not use on cats.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN AND VETERINARIAN: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine is antidotal.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **DO NOT TRANSPORT OR STORE UNDER 32°F.** If freezing occurs, thaw and agitate vigorously.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

ON DOGS AND SLEEPING AREAS: Place dog on a table or bench, preferably out of doors. Hold the container 3 to 6 inches from the dog. Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure that the animal's entire body is covered including the legs and under body. While spraying, fluff the hair so that spray will penetrate to the skin. Make sure spray wets thoroughly. Do not spray the face of the dog. A 16 oz. sprayer should provide 10 to 16 complete treatments on a medium sized dog. One treatment will kill fleas and protect against reinfestation for up to one month. Repeat treatment as necessary. Spray bedding and sleeping area.

Free bitches from fleas before they bear pups. Do Not Use on dogs nursing puppies or on pups under 10 weeks old.

ON PREMISES: To control fleas and brown dog ticks on premises, thoroughly spray infested areas, pet beds, resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, moldings, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor covering. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Concurrent treatment of animals is recommended. Repeat treatment as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store this product in original container and keep in a locked storage area. Do not reuse bottle. Rinse thoroughly and securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
