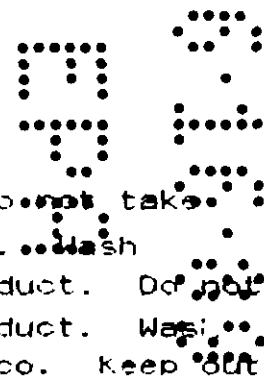

Carbaryl is a carbamate insecticide, which is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal. Narcotics and other sedatives should not be used. Further, drugs like 2-PAM (pyridine-2-aldoxime methiodide) are NOT recommended.

PEST CONTROL AROUND BUILDINGS

PERIMETER TREATMENT: For residual control of ants, brown dog ticks, carpenter ants, centipedes, cockroaches, crickets, earwigs, firebrats and silverfish, fleas, millipedes, scorpions and spiders; apply granules uniformly in a 6 foot band around the building. Apply granules at the rate of 4.8 ounces per 120 square feet (6 x 20 footband). Restrict applications to shrub beds, foundation, plantings, and lawn or soil areas immediately adjacent to the building. Lightly water treated area soon after application.



STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE

Store unused product in original container only, in cool, dry area out of reach of children and animals. Do not store in areas where temperatures frequently exceed 100 degrees F.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
