PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Keep out of reach of children. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing of spray mist. Avoid contact with skin. Avoid contamination of food and feed. Statement of Practical Treatment: If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get immediate medical attention. If inhaled, remove affected person from exposure. If in eyes, rinse with plenty of fresh water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists. If on skin, wash affected area with soap and water. Note to Physician: Malathion is a cholinesterase inhibitor and can cause symptoms similar to those caused by other organic phosphate compounds. Atropine is antidotal.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish, aquatic invertebrates, and aquatic life stages of amphibians. Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Drift and runoff may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in areas near the application site. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds if bees are visiting the treatment area.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flames.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read entire label thoroughly. Apply this product only as specified on this label. DO NOT USE INSIDE THE HOME.

Use as thorough cover spray on all parts of the plant. Repeat as necessary. Keep children and pets off treated areas until material is washed into the soil or the grass is dry. Do not use on Boston, Maiden Hair or Plants Ferns. This product can be used up to 3 days before harvest of fruit crops unless otherwise specified.

ORNAMENTALS: Roses, Azaleas, Gardenias, Camellias, Stocks, Chrysanthemums, and other flowers and shrubs. For Aphids, use 1 1/2 to 2 teaspoons per gallon of water. For Red Spider Mites, Whiteflies, Mealybugs, Waxy Aphids, Flea Leafhoppers, Thrips (exposed), Tarnished Plant or Booklet Bugs, Japanese Beetles (adult), use 1 teaspoon per gallon of water. For Black, Soft Brown, or Oyster Shell Scales, use 1 1/2 to 2 tablespoons per gallon of water.

FRUITS: Grapes. For Aphids, use 1 1/2 to 2 teaspoons per gallon of water. For Red Spider Mites, Mealybugs, Whiteflies, Thrips (exposed), Japanese Beetles (adult), Grape Leafhoppers, or Tarnished Plant Bugs, use 1 tablespoon per gallon of water. For Scale Crawlers, use 1 1/2 to 2 tablespoons per gallon of water.

Do not spray during bloom period. Malathion may injure the foliage of some varieties of Grapes.

CITRUS: Oranges, Lemons, Limes, Grapefruit, or Tangerines. For Aphids; Whiteflies; Scale (Pink, Purple or Yellow), Thrips (exposed), use 2 teaspoons per gallon of water. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest. Do not spray during bloom period.

VEGETABLES: Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Kale, Beans, Peas. For Aphids, use 1 1/2 to 2 teaspoons per gallon of water. For Red Spider Mites, Mealybugs, Whiteflies, Thrips (exposed), Bean Leafhoppers, Japanese Beetles (adult), or Tarnished Plant Bugs, use 1 tablespoon per gallon of water. Do not apply to Broccoli or Peas within 3 days of harvest and to Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower or Kale within 7 days of harvest. Do not spray during bloom period. Do not treat Beans within 1 day of harvest.

For the control of House Flies on patios, around the outside of homes, and garbage containers, use 6 tablespoons per gallon of water. Spray thoroughly around foundations, under porches, along fences, shrubbery, other infested areas.

For the control of household pests around homes: Roaches, Ants, Spiders, Mosquitoes, Silverfish, Crickets, Clovermites, Earwigs, use 8 tablespoons per gallon of water. Apply as a coarse spray or brush around windows, and other areas outside the home.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in original container in a cool place away from sparks or open flame. Keep out of reach of children.

Disposal: Securely wrap original container in several layers of paper and discard in trash. Do not reuse container.
