- 1. Make the following changes to your label:
 - a) In the Precautionary Statements section, delete the following sentences: "Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not use on kittens or nursing puppies. Do not use on kittens or puppies less than 4 weeks of age. Keep out of reach of children." These instructions are repetitious since they also appear in the User Safety Requirements box on the same page. The instructions "do not use on kittens or puppies less than 4 weeks of age" conflicts with the "12 weeks of age" instructions found later in your Directions for Use.
 - b) Move the paragraph located directly beneath the User Safety Requirements box ("Use this product only outside.....using a shaker can or other dust applicator.") to the DIRECTIONS FOR USE section as required in the Agency letter dated 10/1/96.
- 2. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for
