Subject: Label Amendments in Response to Basic Suppliers Deletion of Certain DDVP Uses  
SCMP Vapona Insecticide 90% Concentrated Solution  
EPA Registration No. 769-629  
Your Submission Dated June 15, 1995

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling:

1. Replace the current personal protective equipment (PPE) statements plus the precautionary statements with the statements appearing on the label for Superior DDVP #2 Vapona Insecticide Emulsifiable Concentrate (EPA Registration No. 769-798).
2. The Note to Physician and Warning Symptoms should appear on the front panel following the statement of practical treatment.
3. List the pounds of Dichlorvos per gallon on the front panel.
4. Revise last sentence under Environmental Hazards to read "Do not contaminate water by disposal of equipment washwaters."
5. Under Directions add "Do not apply by air. Do not apply to rangelands."
6. You must specify the outdoor areas where the product can be applied, for example: "Outdoor living areas, picnic areas, backyard areas, patios, loading docks, refuse areas around service stations, open-air drive in, garbage collection and disposal areas."

Submit two copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS  
HAZARDOUS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS  
DANGER**

Poisonous if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin or eyes. Do not get in eyes or on skin. Do not breathe vapor or spray mist. Handle concentrate in ventilated area. Do not get on skin or in eyes. Wear natural rubber gloves, waterproof protective clothing and goggles when handling. Atropine is the emergency antidote. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine. Morphine is contraindicated. Clear chest by postural drainage. Repeated exposure to cholinesterase inhibitors may without warning cause prolonged susceptibility to very small doses of any cholinesterase inhibitor. Allow no further exposure until time for cholinesterase regeneration has been allowed as determined by a blood test. Keep patient prone and quiet.

**WARNING SYMPTOMS:** Symptoms include weakness, headache, tightness in chest, blurred vision, non-reactive pinpoint pupils, salivation, sweating, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, and abdominal cramps.

Vapona Insecticide 90% Concentrated Solution is a specially prepared concentrate for use in fogging devices and conventional application equipment.

Outdoor Areas: To control Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats and other small flying insects. For a 1% to 3% fog or mist solution mix 1 pint Vapona 90% Concentrated Solution with 16 gallons diesel oil (1.0%). Apply as a fog or a fine mist. Apply with fogging apparatus or mist blowers. Dilute Vapona 90% Concentrated Solution with oil to the recommended concentrations and apply at the rate of 0.05 - 0.1 lb. Vapona Insecticide per acre. For example using a 1% fog mist solution apply 5 pints per acre for the 0.05 lb./acre dosage or 1 1/4 gallons per acre for the 0.1 lbs. dosage. DO NOT treat areas where food or feed crops are growing.
