 - b) In the DIRECTIONS FOR USE ON LAWNS, delete the words "both upper and lower leaf surfaces" so that the last sentence in that paragraph reads as follows: "Dust lightly to cover area with a thin, even film of dust."
- 2. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e).
