Dear Ms. Schmidt:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

- 1. Make the following changes to your label:
 - a) In the ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS statement, the second sentence should read "Do not apply directly to water or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark."
 - b) The two paragraphs of use directions that appear directly beneath the User Safety Requirements box should be located in the DIRECTIONS FOR USE section of your label. Specifically, these directions should be located after the directions for Bees, Hornets and Wasps. The directions for Bees, Hornets and Wasps should be kept separate because the directions are different. The general format of the DIRECTIONS FOR USE section should be as follows:

DIRECTIONS FOR USE violation statement

Pest control in and around Domestic Dwellings,....Do not eat honey from treated bee hives.

Wearing household latex or rubber gloves, Do not repeat application more than once a week.

c) In the Directions for Use on Mosquitoes (adults) and also in the Directions for Use on Ticks, change the sentence "Repeat as needed" to "Do not repeat application more than once a week."

d) In the Directions for Use on Ticks, change the word "liberally" to "lightly" to correspond with the directions required in the Agency letter dated 10/1/96.

- e) In the ORNAMENTAL INSECT CONTROL section, change the word "thoroughly" to "lightly." Change the last sentence "repeat at 7 day intervals or as necessary for good insect control" to "Do not repeat applications more than once a week."
- f) Delete the heading "HOW TO USE" and the first sentence of the paragraph "Apply thoroughly to infested plants on upper and lower leaf surfaces at first sign of damage and repeat as necessary." Part of this sentence is contradictory to the Agency letter dated 10/1/96. The appropriate instructions appear earlier in the label.
- g) In the Directions for Use on DOGS & CATS, change the sentence "Repeat at weekly intervals or as needed" to "Do not repeat applications more than once a week."
- 2. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

Start applying at the farthest corner of the treatment area and work backward to avoid contact with dusted surfaces. Allow dust to settle in treated areas before reentering. For plants above chest height, consider using a liquid carbaryl product. Do not repeat application more than once a week.

Sovin® brand carbaryl insecticide 5% Dust to soil surface, mulch and debris around moist, shady places. Fleas - Apply 5 to 10 lbs per 5,000 sq ft Sevin® brand carbaryl insecticide 5% Dust and liberally to pens, yards, lawns and under buildings around home. Force dust into cracks and crevices. Repeat as needed. Millipedes - Apply 10 to 15 lbs per 5,000 sq ft Sevin® brand carbaryl insecticide 5% Dust to soil surface, mulch and debris around moist, shady places. Apply thoroughly to infested plants on upper and lower leaf surfaces at first sign of damage and repeat as necessary Do not apply within 3 days of harvest on Head lettuce, Cabbage, Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cauliflower, Turnips and Cowpeas. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest on Collards, Leaf lettuce, and Spinach. Application of this product to the tassel region of corn during the pollen shed period will seriously reduce bee populations. Note: Subsequent planting of food and feed crops in treated soil must be made with crops on this or other carbaryl label(s).

PETS - DOGS & CATS

Use this product only outside or in a well-ventilated area. Wearing household latex or rubber gloves, dust entire animal, avoiding pet's eyes, nose, mouth and genital areas. Rub or brush pet's hair to work dust down to the skin. This product should not be applied by children. Do not use on pregnant dogs. Do not use on kittens or puppies under 12

weeks of age. Dust bedding and doghouse using a shaker can or other dust applicator.

Note: Do not use on pregnant dogs. For Fleas, Lice and Ticks: Dust liberally over animal and rub thoroughly into skin. For Brown Dog Ticks: Be sure to also apply on legs, feet and between toes. Comb out dead ticks a few hours after treatment. Keep dust out of eyes. Apply in and around sleeping quarters, kennels and dog houses. Force dust into cracks and crevices. Repeat at weekly intervals or as needed.
