The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling incorporating the following corrections before you release the product for shipment. The corrections specified in items 1. a. through 1.f. are needed to maintain consistency with the particular citrus use pattern being supported by the basic registrants. Product labels deviating from this supported use pattern will be subject to the additional data requirements needed to support such deviations.

A copy of the basic producers' registered label for the use of ethion on citrus (EPA Reg. No. 279-1254) is enclosed for your reference.

- a. Specify the citrus crops to be treated with the product as grapefruit, lemons, limes, oranges, tangelos and tangerines.
- b. Specify a preharvest interval (PHI) of 15 days for tangelos and tangerines.
- c. Specify the application rate in terms of the amount of product to be applied per acre based on a maximum allowable rate of 3.0 pounds of active ingredient per acre.
- d. Add directions to apply not less than 250 gallons of water per acre for ground application and a minimum of 10 gallons of water per acre for aerial application.
- e. Add a statement limiting the maximum application to no more than 9 pounds of active ingredient per acre per year.

- f. The use of ethion on citrus is subject to a restricted reentry interval (REI) of 48 hours and this REI must appear on the label as part of the required worker protection standard labeling (WPS).
- g. Add the following statement directly under the heading, "Directions for Use".

"It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling."

- . h. Since the use on ornamentals has been deleted, the product name, "X-Cel Citrus & Ornamental Spray Insecticide" must be corrected to read "X-Cel Citrus Spray Insecticide".
- i. As specified in the Reregistration Standard issued for ethion in September, 1989, your environmental hazards statements must be revised as stated below.

"This pesticide is toxic to fish, and aquatic invertebrates. Fish and aquatic invertebrates may be killed in areas where this pesticide is used. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

- j. As presently labeled, the subject product falls within the scope of the WPS labeling and the appropriate WPS labeling must be added to the label before the subject product is released for shipment. According to our computer records, no WPS labeling has been submitted for the product.
- 2. At the next printing of your label, update your label by separating out and reformatting the human and environmental precautionary statements, statements of practical treatment, physical/chemical hazards and storage and disposal statements under the appropriate headings. Refer to the enclosed basic producers ethion label for the correct format and headings for these statements.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
