The labeling cited above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is accepted subject to the comments reflected on the enclosed sheet. A copy of your proposed labeling stamped "ACCEPTED WITH COMMENTS" is enclosed.

WHAT THIS ACCEPTANCE MEANS:

Based on your certification, the Agency has accepted the labeling changes that are necessary to comply with the Worker Protection Standard (WPS) labeling requirements of 40 CFR part 156, subpart K, described in PR Notices 93-7 and 93-11. Any other labeling changes submitted in connection with this amendment application but not directly related to compliance with the WPS have not been reviewed or accepted by the Agency. If you wish to make such changes, you must submit a separate amendment application proposing them. If your product is currently suspended, the acceptance of this labeling amendment does not affect the suspension in any way.



The following specific comments pertain to your WPS labeling submission concerning the product cited above:

User Safety Recommendations must either be placed in a box or printed on the label in a contrasting color from surrounding text.

You may delete the respirator statement added to your proposed label. It is not required for your product.

Insert the following statement above the Agricultural Use Requirements box: "Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. For any requirements specific to your State or Tribe, consult the agency responsible for pesticide regulation." The exact location is shown in Section F on Part 2 of the Product Worksheet in Supplement Three-A to PR Notice 93-7.

You have incorrect wording in the second-to-last sentence in the first paragraph in the Agricultural Use Requirements box on your proposed label. The sentence must be as follows: "It also contains specific instructions and exceptions pertaining to the statements on this label about personal protective equipment (PPE), and restricted-entry interval."

The bodywear requirement for early entry in the Agricultural Use Requirements box on your proposed labeling is missing or incorrect. Remove the incorrect requirement (if any) and add "Coveralls". The exact location is shown in Sections F and G on Part 2 of the Product Worksheet in Supplement Three-A to PR Notice 93-7.

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. This Standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification, and emergency assistance. SPECIFIC DIRECTIONS

The following numbered paragraphs correspond to numbers in parenthesis (x) on the front panel following the insect names. Insects not numbered may be controlled by following the GENERAL DIRECTIONS. Repeat treatments as needed for control.

(1) CHIGGERS, TICKS, & FLEAS

Use 1 lb./200 sq. ft. (5 lb./1,000 sq. ft.) for area control of these insects, infesting non-crop land areas such as roadsides, footpaths, and trails, picnic and camping sites, parks and other recreational areas where these pests are present and create a nuisance or a possible public health problem. DO NOT allow public use of treated area during applications. For Fleas (out-of-doors, only) treat sleeping quarters and other areas frequented by pets such as beneath porches and along fencing.

(2) SOD WEBWORMS

For Sod Webworms, delay watering or mowing the treated area for 12 to 24 hours after treatment. Treat in the spring or when insects first appear troublesome. Additional treatments at 30 day intervals may be needed for new infestations. Apply at rate of 5 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.

(3) TURFGRASS WEEVIL

Use 25 lbs. per 2,500 sq. ft.). Treat suspected problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-May or as recommended by your local Agricultural Extension Service Specialist.

(4) WHITE GRUBS; CRANE FLY LARVAE

To control White Grubs (Black Turfgrass Ataenius, European Chafer, Southern Masked Chafer, Japanese Beetle and June Beetle Larvae), use 25 lbs to treat 2,500 sq. ft. After applications apply enough water to thoroughly wash the insecticide into the turf. For best results remove thatch first & treat when grubs are young and actively feeding near the soil surface, usually during late July and August. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service Specialist for best time to treat. European Crane Fly larvae will be controlled using 25 lbs per 3,600 sq. ft. or will be controlled simultaneously with the same application being applied for control of "White Grubs" i.e. (25 lbs./2,500 sq. ft.). Consult your Agricultural Agent for proper time to apply. For best results, first remove thatch. Water the grubs into the soil.

(5) BLUEGRASS BILLBUGS

Use 25 lbs./2,500 sq. ft. for Billbug grubs. Remove thatch before treatment. Wash granules into soil.

(6) IMPORTED FIRE ANT CONTROL

To control Fire Ants, apply 4 ounces evenly over and around each mound. After application of granules, gently sprinkle the treated area with a minimum of 1 quart water per 6 inches of mound diameter. For best results; do not disturb the mound before or during the application; apply in cool weather (65-80 F); or in early morning or later evening. Treat new mounds as they appear.
