AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. This Standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. Mole Crickets In Lawns, Golf Courses, Sod Farms, Ornamental and Recreational Turf: Apply this product uniformly using any hand or power operated gravity or rotary type spreader designed for application of granules at the rate of 2 ¼ lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. (equivalent to 100 lbs. per acre) to home lawns, golf courses, sod farms, and any other ornamental and recreational turf and non-crop land areas. Use the higher rate for serious mole cricket infestations. For best results if insect populations are serious, plan on a second treatment in about 7 to 10 days.

Mole Crickets in Flower Beds and Landscapes: In addition to the control of Mole Crickets apply this product uniformly to control Ants, Sowbugs, Field Crickets, Cutworms, Earwigs, and Darkling Beetles at the rate of 2 ½ lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. Apply in late afternoon when soil is moist to areas where insects are seen or are feeding. Replace product as needed for continued control. To control adult Mole Crickets apply between February and September.

Insect Control Around Homes, Offices and Commercial Buildings: Use For Crawling Insect Control Outside of Homes. Apartments, Condominiums, Warehouses, Hospitals, Schools, Food Handling Establishments and Commercial Buildings. To protect against insects entering the indoors, a protective band of this product granules may be placed around the outside of buildings to control Ants, Cockroaches, Field and Mole Crickets, Earwigs, Millipedes, Sowbugs and Springtails before they attempt to enter. Use 1 pound to treat 200 sq. ft. (as a band 5 ft. x 40 ft. long) around the structure. Apply when insect have become troublesome or before they cause problems in the spring or early fall. Repeat one month later and then as needed for control, but not more than once every 7 days.

Imported Fire Ant- Mound Treatment: For treatment of Fire Ant mounds occurring in lawns, turf and premise areas, treat individual ant mounds measuring from 3 to 12 inches in diameter by applying 8 tablespoonfuls (1.6 oz.) of granules evenly in a circle around the outer edges (1 to 2 feet from the center) of the mound. Finish the treatment by applying 5 tablespoonfuls (1 oz.) sprinkled evenly over the center of the mound. Best results will be obtained if mound is not disturbed after treatment thus allowing ants to come and go and to be exposed to the insecticide. Repeat treatments as needed for additional control, but not more than once every 7 days.

Lawns, Golf Courses and Ornamental Turfgrass - Surface Feeding Insects: Use 2 ½ to 2 ½ lbs. (1,000 sq. ft.) for control of Ants Armyworms, (such as Beet, Fall, Yellowstriped), Centipedes, Chinch bugs, Cutworms, Crickets, Earwigs, Grasshoppers, Millipedes, Sod Webworms (lawn moth), and Sowbugs. For Sod webworms also apply at rate of 2 ½ to 2 ½ lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft., but delay watering or mowing the treated area for 12 to 24 hours after treatment. Treat in the spring or when insects first appear troublesome. Additional treatments at 30 day intervals may be needed for new infestations. It is not necessary to water the insecticide in to control these surface insects.
