SMCP Pyrethrins ULV Fogging Concentrate

EPA Reg. No. 769-719

Application dated: August 6, 2007

Dear Mr. Rogosheske,

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided you:

- 1. Revise the optional marketing claims. Data were not submitted or cited to support these claims.
 - a. Change "Provides rapid kill of listed insects" to "Kills listed insects." or remove the claim.
 - b. Change "Controls listed crawling and flying insects." to "Kills listed crawling insects." or remove the claim.
 - c. Remove "Quick acting-leaves no harmful residues."
 - d. Change "Dilutable in oil only." to "Dilute only with oil-based solvents as directed by this label." or remove the claim.
- 2. Place an asterisk after "pyrethrins" in the ingredient statement. This footnote should read as "*1 gallon contains 0.21 lbs pyrethrins."
- 3. Change the "* piperonyl butoxide" in the ingredient statement to ** and place it after this ingredient. Change the corresponding footnote.
- 4. Add a triple asterisk *** after n-octyl bicycloheptene dicarboximide. The footnote should read "*** MGK-264 insecticide synergist"

- 5. Change "** Contains petroleum distillates" to read "**** Contains petroleum distillates."
- 6. Revise the precautionary statement "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" to read:

"Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Avoid breathing spray mist. When space spraying wear a mask or respirator with an organic vapor removing cartridge with a prefilter approved for pesticides (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-23C), or a canister approved for pesticides (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-14G), or a NIOSH approved respirator with an organic vapor (OV) cartridge or canister with any N, R, P or HE prefilter.

- 7. Revise the "Physical Chemical Hazard Statement" to read: "Combustible. Do not use or store near heat or open flame."
- 8. Revise the "Environmental Hazard Statement" to read:

"This product is toxic to aquatic organism, including fish and invertebrates. Do not contaminate bodies of water when disposing of equipment rinsate or wash waters." Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Drift from treated areas may be hazardous to organisms in adjacent aquatic sites."

- 9. Revise the "Directions for Use" as follows:
 - a. General Precautions and Restrictions
 - i. Revise: "Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying." to read: "Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums and turn off pump motor before application."
 - ii. Add the statement:" In health care facilities, remove patients prior to treatment and thoroughly ventilate treated area for 2 hours before returning patients."
 - iii. Add the statement: "Do not apply directly to food."
 - iv. Revise "Do not use in aircraft cabins except in compliance with PR Notice 96-3." to read: "Do not use in aircraft cabins."
 - b. How to Use: Revise to read
 - i. How To Use: This concentrate is designed for use undiluted in mechanical sprayers that deliver aerosol size droplets (30 microns or less). It can be diluted with refined kerosene that conforms to Food Additive regulations as described in 40CFR 180.930 (Inert ingredients applied to <u>animals</u>, exemptions from the requirement for a tolerance) or an odorless light petroleum oil

conforming to 21CFR 172.882 or 40 CFR 180.910 (Inert ingredients used <u>preand post-harvest</u>, exemptions from a tolerance).

Note to the registrant: kerosene cannot be used in all food facilities! Please see http://www.epa.gov/opprd001/inerts/decisiondoc_a2k.html#K for information regarding the tolerance reassessment for kerosene.

- c. Space Spray: Undiluted in Aerosol Generator
 - i. Change "Apply at the rate of 1.0 ounce of undiluted concentrate per 5,000 cubic feet of space." to read as previously approved language: "Apply at the rate of 1.0 ounce of undiluted concentrate per 1,000 cubic feet of space."
- d. Contact Spray:
 - i. Change "1,000 square feet of space" to read "1,000 cubic feet of space".
- e. "NOTE:" at the bottom of Page 3.
 - i. Revise the note because the current text does not make sense.
- f. Add "Do not use on dogs or cats." to the label.
- 10. Storage and Disposal Instructions.
 - a. Review PR Notices 2007-1 and 2007-4 for new regulations and statements related to pesticide containers and disposal.
 - b. Combine the Storage and Disposal instructions as follows:

STORAGE and DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in original container upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to temperatures more than (insert temperature) degrees or less than (insert temperature) degrees. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with absorbent material such as sand earth, fuller's earth, or other appropriate material. Dispose of product and damaged container as described below.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal < 5 gallons: Nonrefillable. Do not reuse or refill this container. Empty container by using the product in accordance with label directions. Place empty container in trash or offer for recyling if available. If partly filled call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

Container Disposal ≥ 5 gallons: Empty container by using the product in accordance with label directions. Triple rinse (or equivalent) promptly after emptying then off for recycling or reconditioning, if available. Otherwise, puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill.

11. Name and Address: You must add a street address to the label. A post office box is not sufficient.



GENERAL PRECAUTIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

When used as a space spray or fog, do not remain in treated area. Exit area immediately and remain outside the treated area until aerosols, vapors, and/or mists have dispersed. Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter until vapors, mists, and aerosols have dispersed, and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated.

Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application.

Remover or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment, and food preparation surfaces, or wash them before use.

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Do not use in aircraft cabins except in compliance with PR Notice 96-3.

How To Use: This concentrate is designed for use undiluted in mechanical sprayers which give particle sizes of aerosol size. It can be diluted with refined kerosene's which meet Food Additive Regulations and can be applied in fogging equipment that gives larger than aerosol particle size. It can also be diluted with oil specified above and applied as a contact spray to kill crawling insects shown on this label.

SPACE SPRAY

<u>Undiluted in Aerosol Generator</u> – To kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Gnats. Close room and shut off all air-conditioning or ventilating equipment. Apply at the rate of 1.0 ounce of undiluted concentrate per 5,000 cubic feet of space. Direct output from aerosol generator upward towards upper corners of room and ceiling. Leave room closed for one half hour. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

<u>Diluted for Ordinary Mechanical Fogging Equipment</u> - Close room and shut off all air-conditioning or ventilating equipment. Dilute concentrate with oil at the rate of 1 part concentrate plus 29 parts of oil and mix well. Apply at the rate of 50 fluid ounces diluted spray (0.4 gallons) per 25,000 cubic feet of space. Direct fog upward towards corners of room and ceiling area. Leave room closed for one half hour. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

Do not make space spray applications when facility is in operation. Do not apply at any time as an undiluted space spray in edible product areas of federally inspected meat and poultry plants. During space spray applications, cover or remove food. During space spray applications, cover food processing surfaces or clean after treatment with a suitable detergent and rinse with potable water before use. Do not apply more than 1 time per day.

CONTACT SPRAY

Diluted for use with sprayers that give large, wetting spray particles – to kill Cockroaches and accessible stages of Granary Insects: Granary Weevils, Rice Weevils, Confused Flour Beetles, Red Flour Beetles, Meal Moth larvae and adults, Cadelles, Grain Mites and Saw-toothed Grain Beetles. Dilute concentrate with oil at the rate of 1 part concentrate plus 29 parts of oil and mix well. Spray outside walls of grain bins, flooring, around base of milling machinery, wall and baseboards, areas behind cabinets, around pipes and other insect harborages using one gallon spray per 1,000 square feet of space. Force spray into all cracks and crevices. Repeat application as necessary. Do not apply more than 1 time per day.

Note: Infested stored food products should be furnigated or treated by either effective methods using an approved product intended for this purpose.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE AND SPILL PROCEDURES: Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperatures. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, fuller's earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical wastes.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of at or by and approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved state and local procedures.

For containers on gallon or less:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store product in its original container in a cool dry area out of reach of children and pets.

Container Disposal: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled**: Call your local solid waste authority for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
