Subject Label Amendments in Response to Basic Suppliers Deletion of Certain DDVP Uses PCE Malathion DDVP Residual Spray EPA Registration No. 769-752 Your Submission Dated June 15, 1995

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling

- Change signal word back to CAUTION on the front and side panel.
- 2 Revise the front panel to read as follows:

Indoor crack and crevice use in nonfood/feed areas of commercial/institutional and industrial areas; domestic dwellings (including campers, hotel, motels, tourist courts). For outdoor use including patios and lawns; kennels, including outside runways, window sills and ledges; outside surfaces of buildings, including porches, screens, window frames, eaves, patios, garages; refuse dumps; refuse and solid waste containers; wine cellars.

3. Under Directions for Use add the following statements:

For indoor use, only crack and crevice treatments are permitted. Space spray use is prohibited. Do not use in hospitals or clinical rooms, such as patient rooms, wards, nurseries, operating or emergency areas. Do not use in any rooms where infants, or the sick or aged are, or will be present for any extended period of confinement.

Do not use in food/feed handling establishments, restaurants, or areas where food/feed is prepared, processed or stored. Do not use to treat non-perishable bagged and/or bulk stored raw or processed agricultural commodities. In the heme do not use in kitchens unless food/feed are removed or covered during treatment Cover all food/feed preparation surfaces, dishes and food/feed handling equipment before

treatment. Thoroughly wash all food/feed preparation surfaces, dishes and food/feed handling

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- 4. Following the For Sale to, Use and Storage statement on front panel add: "Do not treat more than 5 applications sites per day and do not make DDVP applications more than once per week."
- 5. The ingredient statement should declare the active ingredient as: "Dichlorvos [2,2-dichlorovinyl....."
- 6. Under Directions for Use add:

Nonfood/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments where products can be applied include areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewer entries and vestibules), offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

- 7. Add the following prohibition "Not for Use in Federally Inspected Meat and Poultry Plants."
- 8. Revise last statement under Environmental Hazards to areas "Do not contaminate water by disposal of equipment washwaters."
- 9. Add following under Storage and Disposal

Drum Handling: Handle carefully to prevent drainage and leakage. Open drums only when set on end and under a ventilated hood. Unscrew bungs slowly to release internal pressure.

Submit two copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
