The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below.

1. Revise the Environmental Hazards statement by replacing the phrase "disposal of wastes" with "disposal of equipment washwaters."

2. Correct (update) the Disclaimer by deleting the reference to SMCP and replacing it with the new registrant's name; Sureco.

We note that you have requested that these labels be accepted, with comments, and that you will immediately correct and resubmit new labels. Although the comments we have represent only minor changes, the labels you have submitted are barely legible. 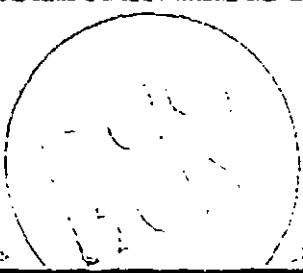

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GENERAL INFORMATION

GENERAL: This product must be applied using a compressed air sprayer. Do not apply this product using a trigger pump sprayer. Spray surfaces only will coated with a dew like mist. Avoid run-off. Apply to insect breeding sites and harborages. Also treat adjacent exposed surfaces where insects may crawl when they come out of hiding. Repeat treatment as necessary.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Apply this product only as specified on the label.

Applications of this product in the food areas of food-handling establishments other than as a crack and crevice treatment are not permitted.

FOOD-HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS: Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served. **Food Areas:** Application oriented to cracks and crevices throughout any structure areas for receiving, storage, packing (cleaning, bottling, wrapping, boxing), preparing waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, gauges, mills and, syring). Serving areas where food is exposed and ready to be consumed is food area. Apply in areas mentioned directly into cracks and crevices using position capable of dispensing a stream of insecticide, where Roaches, Weevils and Sawflies hide in parts between different elements of construction; between equipment and wood; under motor housing, junction or switch boxes. Aids in the control of Pantry Pests: Household stages of Saw-toothed Grain Beets, Flour beetle, Free Weevils, Cigarette beetle, and Indian Meal Moth; which come in contact with treated surfaces.

Serving areas: Facilities where prepared food is served, such as dining rooms, bar, reception areas where foods may be prepared or held. Overhead, Crawl, Eaves, Millwork, Beams, Sillings and Siding: Thoroughly spray the areas and avoid perimeter of the structure.

Basement, Crawl, Eaves, Millwork, Beams, Sillings and Siding: Thoroughly spray the areas and avoid perimeter of the structure.
