STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately. Note To Physician: Contains petroleum distillate. If gastric lavage is necessary, undertake only after proper placement of a cuffed endotracheal tube. Active ingredients contain a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine is an antidote.

If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If On Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If In Eyes: Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician if irritation persists.




It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

General Information: INDOOR USE IS LIMITED TO SPOT TREATMENT AND/OR CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY.

Spray surfaces until wet. Retreat as needed, Do not spray in the air. Do not use on plants.

FOOD-HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS: Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served. Do not apply when facility is in operation or foods are exposed. Do not treat surfaces likely to be contacted by food. Do not spray into the air.

Food Areas: Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing), preparing edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups). Areas where food may be prepared or held are considered food areas (this does not include areas where food is served such as dining rooms). Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using equipment capable of delivering a pinstream of insecticide, where Cockroaches, Waterbugs, and Silverfish hide; in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors; openings leading to voids and hollows spaces in walls,



equipment legs and bases, conduits, motor housing, junction or switch boxes. Prior to application, de-energize electrical equipment. After application, allow time for oil to evaporate before starting motors or placing switches in the ON position.

Aids in the control of Pantry Pests (exposed stages of Saw-toothed Grain Beetle, Flour Beetle, Rice Weevil, Cigarette Beetle and Indian Meal Moth) which come in contact with treated surfaces.

Serving Areas: Facilities where prepared food is served, such as dining rooms. But excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. Apply as a spot treatment to selective surfaces such as baseboards, under elements of construction, into cracks and crevices.

Non-food Areas: Includes garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling). Apply as a spot treatment to baseboards areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter.

LOCATIONS OTHER THAN FOOD-HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS: Apply as a course (large droplet) spray to localized areas where pests may appear. Spray surfaces until wet. Retreat as needed. Do not spray in the air. Do not use on plants.


Cockroaches, Ants, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders: Spray dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards, and around door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets; and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For Ants, apply to ant rails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance.

Brown Dog Ticks: To control these pests, thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas. **DO NOT SPRAY PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT.** Treat pets with a EPA approved product registered for pet use.

Flies and Mosquitoes: Use only out-of-doors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when effectiveness diminishes.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate, food or feed by storage and disposal.



STORAGE: Avoid storage at high temperatures. Protect from moisture. Avoid contamination with water, acids or alkalies. Do not store near heat or open flame. Keep container closed. Store in original containers only. Separate pesticides to avoid cross-contamination of other pesticides, fertilizer, food or feed. Keep container in locked areas. If spilled, absorb with dry material such as sand or sawdust and sweep up for disposal.
