FIRST AID

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

### Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

#### DANGER

Corrosive – causes eye damage. Causes skin irritation. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing spray mist. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling, before eating or smoking. Avoid contamination of food.

When using this product wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes, chemical resistant gloves and eye protection. It is recommended that safety glasses included front, brow and temple protection.

After using this product, rinse gloves before removing, remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water. Remove saturated clothing as soon as possible and shower.

### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present, or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water used for irrigation or domestic purposes. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label. Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system. Do not allow people (other than applicator) or pets on treatment area during application. Do not enter treatment area until spray has dried or dust has settled.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**STORAGE:** Store in tightly closed, original container in a locked area away from children and domestic animals. Do not store near fertilizer, seeds or other pesticides. Open dumping is prohibited.

**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

**OTHER PRECAUTIONS:** Use only in areas where complete control of all vegetation is desired. When applied to the soil, plant growth will be inhibited for a year or more. Do not use on lands to be used for crops or desirable trees. Apply as a coarse spray. Do not apply when weather conditions may cause drift or run off from the target area. Do not use sprayer used for weed control to apply other pesticides to desirable plants or crops. Do not use in greenhouses. Vapors from this product may injure susceptible plants in immediate vicinity.

### GENERAL USE DIRECTIONS

For total weed control on noncrop areas, industrial site, fence row, tennis courts, driveways, parking lots, patios. This product kills most young weeds and grass on contact and deposits a chemical residue in the soil. This residue inhibits annual weed and grass seeds from germinating during the entire growing season. Contact activity will be apparent in a few days. Final kill by root penetration may take from 2 to 3 weeks. For best results on established weeds they must be actively growing with sufficient rainfall. Dry soil and insufficient rainfall will limit the translocation within the plant and prevent penetration into the soil.

For best results, apply in the early Spring before weeds germinate. If weeds have germinated, apply before they are four inches tall. During seasons of unusually high rainfall, a second application may be necessary.

For general weed and grass control in walks, driveways, graveled areas, industrial yards, fire lanes, tank farms and along fence rows: Apply 12.75 gallons of Triple X NA Weed Killer in 50 to 100 gallons of water per acre or one gallon in 15 to 30 gallons of water to cover 3,380 square feet, or 1¼ quarts in 5 to 10 gallons of water per 1,000 square feet.

For areas where heavy grass and weed growth is present and where vegetation is more than 24 inches high, mow or cut to 8 inch height before applying. Use sufficient volume of spray to thoroughly cover all foliage. To control deep rooted perennials such as Milkweed and Canada Thistle, a second application may be necessary in 2 to 3 months.
