We have received the above two letters and associated revised labels. Our comments follow.

A. Submission of June 20, 1996

You submitted this letter and label in response to our June 11, 1996, letter. We received this submission on January 16, 1997, and placed it in our files for this product. Since we will be stamping labeling associated with your January 9, 1997, letter, we have not reviewed or stamped the submitted labeling.

B. Submission of January 9, 1997

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the following changes and submit one (1) copy to us before you ship your product:

1. Under your product name, revise the text to read:

Dust or Spray for Vegetables, Berries, Small Fruits, and Ornamentals. For Home Gardens Only

2. Change the ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS section to read:

This product is extremely toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Runoff and drift from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in adjacent sites. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

Application Directions:

AS A DUST: Apply directly from this container through the sifter top or apply with a hand duster. Apply to upper and lower leaf surfaces.

AS A SPRAY: Spray upper and lower leaf surfaces thoroughly, to the point of runoff.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

As A Spray: Make a paste by stirring 4 heaping tablespoons in a little water. Mix this paste with water to make a gallon of spray. When spraying, shake sprayer occasionally to maintain an effective suspension.

Asparagus, Beans, Beets (table), Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Carrots, Cauliflower, Collard, Cucumbers, Eggplant, Kale, Kohlrabi, Lettuce, Melons, Mint, Mustard greens, Okra, Peppers, Pumpkins, Radishes, Rutabagas, Squash, Swiss chard, Tomatoes, Turnips. Controls: Aphids (except waxy cabbage aphid), asparagus beetles (twelve-spotted), Pean leaf beetle, Imported cabbage worms, Colorado potato beetles, cucumber beetles, Flea beetles, Mexican bean beetles, pepper maggots, squash vine borers, vegetable we-vils.

BERRIES AND SMALL FRUITS

Blackberry, Blueberry, boysenberry, Cherry, Currant, Dewberry, Gooseberry, Grape, Loganberry, Raspberry, Strawberry

Controls: Blueberry maggots, Cherry fruitflies, Flea beetles, Gooseberry fruitworms, Imported currant worms, Japanese beetles, Raspberry cane borers, Raspberry fruitworms, Raspberry sawfly, Red-necked cane borers, Spittle bugs, Strawberry leaf beetles.

Flowers, Ornamentals, Shrubs and Vines: Use a dust or spray on flowers, ornamentals, shrubs or vines to control certain aphids, Japanese beetles, lace bugs and rose slugs.
