TO KILL TICKS: Remove and destroy old pet bedding. Apply this product as for other insects. Put fresh bedding in pets quarters after treatment. Treat dogs and cats with a registered tick control prtoduct before allowing them to enter.

Cover exposed foods, dishes and food handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve open away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit foreach 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press alve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in center of room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for several hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

TO KILL FLEAS: Follow directions for Ticks, but use one can per 1,500 cubic feet.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
