PESTS OUT-OF-DOORS

General information - Use this product for control of certain pests on outside surfaces of buildings and on lawns and ornamentals plants, and for area control of Chiggers. Consult the following directions for dosage and application details to control the pests listed.

PESTS ON OUTSIDE SURFACES OF BUILDINGS: Use this product at the rate of 2 3/4 ounces per gallon of water to control Ants, Clover Mites, Cockroaches, Crickets, Earwigs, Fleas, Flies, Millipedes, Mosquitoes, Sowbugs, Spiders, and Ticks by application as a residual spray to outside surfaces of buildings, including porches, screens, window frames, eaves, patios, garages, refuse dumps, and other areas where these pests congregate or have been seen. Do not treat or allow the spray to contact plants (lawns, flowering plants, shrubs, trees, evergreen, etc.) because of possible injury. Repeat treatment as needed to maintain effectiveness.

NOTE: To help prevent infestations of buildings by Ants, Crickets, Earwigs, Millipedes, and Sowbugs, (Pillbugs) treat a band of soil 6 to 10 feet wide around and adjacent to buildings, also building foundations to a height of 2 to 3 feet, where pests are active and may find entrance. Use 16 ounces (1 Pint) in 100 gallons of water and apply as a coarse spray at the rate of about 10 gallons of spray mixture per 1,000 sq. ft. to thoroughly and uniformly wet the band area.

PESTS OF LAWNS, OTHER ORNAMENTAL AND RECREATIONAL TURF AREAS AND PERENNIAL TURF GRASSES GROWN FOR SEED.

Use this product to control the following pests as listed by application at the recommended dosages and in accordance with the direction given below. Dilute in enough water to obtain complete and uniform coverage of pest infested areas and apply as a coarse, low pressure spray using suitable spray equipment. Thoroughly water after treatment to wash the insecticide into the turf, except as noted. For best results, the lawn should be moist at the time of treatment.

PEST OF ORNAMENTALS

Use this product to treat flowers, shrubs, vines, shade trees and flowering trees and evergreens found to be infested with the following pests as listed. Dilute with water according to directions given in the table and apply using suitable hand or power spray equipment in a manner to provide complete coverage. For best results, apply a wetting spray to both upper and lower leaf surfaces and infested limb and trunk area. Attempt to penetrate dense foliage but avoid overspraying. Treat when pests appear and repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals, if needed. **CAUTION:** Do not use on Azaleas, Camellias, Poinsettias, Rose Bushes, or Variegated by because of possible injury to foliage.

DOSAGES AND DIRECTIONS FOR USE ON ORNAMENTAL PLANTS

For control of Aphids, Mites, Bagworms, Orange-striped Oakworm, Eastern Tent caterpillar, Spittlebug, Fall Webworm, Whiteflies, Grasshoppers, Yellow-necked Caterpillar, use 0.5 fl.oz./7.5 gals. - 1.6 fl.oz./10 gals. - 1 PT/100 gals.
For control of Cutworms, Leafhoppers, Mealybugs, Mimosas Webworms, Red Humped Caterpillar, Thrips(Exposed Stage), use 1.0 fl.oz./7.5 gals. - 3.2 fl.oz./10 gals. - 1 QT/100 gals.
For control of Ash Borer, Lilac Borer, Dogwood Borer, (Scale Crawlers, Oak Lecanium, Pine Needle, Tea, and White Birch) - Scale Insects, use 2.0 fl.oz./7.5 gals. - 6.4 fl.oz./10 gals. - 2 Qts/100 gals.

STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT ORGANOPHOSPHATE

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. If possible vomiting should be induced under medical supervision. Have victim drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person. **IF INHALED:** Get to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. Call a physician and get medical attention immediately. **IF ON SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing. Wash affected area with soap and water. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken orally.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Poisonous if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin or eyes. Do not get in eyes. Do not breathe fumes. Rapidly absorbed through the skin.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN - POISONING SYMPTOMS

Symptoms include weakness, headache, tightness in chest, blurred vision, non-reactive pupils, sweating, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, and abdominal cramps. **TREATMENT** - Atropine is the drug of choice against parasympathetic nervous stimulation. If there are signs of para-atropine Sulfate should be injected at 10 minute intervals, in doses of 1 to 2 milligrams until control of symptoms is achieved. Morphine is contraindicated, 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with postural drainage. Repeated exposure to cholinesterase inhibitors may without warning result in susceptibility to very small amounts of cholinesterase inhibitors. Allow no further exposure until regeneration has been allowed as determined by a blood test. This product contains an aerosolized solvent which may cause aspiration pneumonia.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

Some materials that are chemical-resistant to this product are listed below. If you want more information on these materials, contact your local EPA chemical resistance category selection chart.

Applicators and other handlers: must wear: Coveralls over long sleeved shirt and long pants. Chemical-resistant gloves such as Barrier Laminate or Viton; Chemical resistant footwear plus socks; Protective eyewear for overhead exposure; Chemical resistant apron when cleaning equipment; A respirator approved for use with a prefilter approved for pesticides (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-14G). **Discard clothing and other absorbent materials** that have been sprayed or heavily contaminated with this product.
