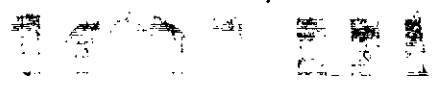

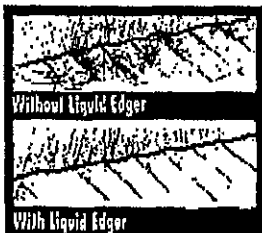

HOW TO USE SPOT WEED TREATMENT

This product is read-to-use. Applicator should wear waterproof gloves during treatment. For treatment of individual weeds (spot treatment) remove the cap which covers the applicator head, invert jug several inches above ground and sprinkle liquid to treat weeds in and along sidewalks, patio blocks, driveways and spot weed control in the lawn. Product will cause brown or yellowing dead spots in lawn. Repeat as needed for continued weed edging.

TREATMENT FOR LAWN REJUVENATION

The area should be mowed before treatment. For broadcast application to renovate portions of a lawn, the contents of this container will treat up to a measured area of 300 sq.ft. Invert the container and sprinkle directly onto weedy growth. May also be applied with a garden pressure sprayer. A second application 5 days later may be required for complete kill of Bermudagrass and other deep rooted perennials. When foliage is all brown the area should be raked and bare spots prepared for seed. About 5 days after last treatment, water thoroughly and then seed at the recommended rate for a new lawn. Seed should be raked into soil and kept moist to hasten germination. Do not allow Liquid-Edger to come in contact with the foliage, root or bark areas of desirable plants since injury may occur.

STORAGE and DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store product in original container in a cool, dry, locked place out of reach of children. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.
