AllPro Baracide 5PS Pellated Herbicide  
EPA Reg. No. 769-978  
Submission dated August 7, 2007

The labeling, referred to above, submitted in connection with the application under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided you make the following changes:

Your product is formulated in the liquid form.

1. Heading"

- Add a statement on weight of prometon per gallon.
- Change EPA Est. "44616-MO-2" to "769-MO-2."

2. Under "Precautionary Statements"

Remove "safety glasses."

3. Add a section on "Personal Protective Equipment," and add the following requirements if this product is acceptable for occupational use:

- Applicators and other handlers must wear chemical goggles or face shield, chemical resistant gloves made of waterproof materials, long sleeved shirt and pants, shoes and socks.
- Follow the manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

4. It is recommended that you add the following use safety recommendation requirements:

- Users should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet.
- Users should remove clothing/PPE immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing.
- Users should remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing.

5. Under "Environmental Hazards";

Replace "Do not contaminate water when cleaning equipment" with "Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters or rinsate. Drift and runoff may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in water adjacent to treated areas."


6. Under "Directions for Use":

Add the following statements:

- Do not enter or allow others to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.
- Do not allow people or pets to touch treated plants until the sprays have dried.
- Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application.

The amended label supersedes all previously accepted labels. A stamped copy of the revised label is enclosed for your records. Please submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

Baracide 5PS is a nonselective herbicide that can be applied before or after plant growth begins. Since Baracide 5PS enters plants through their roots, its effectiveness is dependent on rainfall to move the chemical into the root zone. Very dry soil conditions and lack of rainfall may result in poor weed control.

**Important:** Use only in areas where complete control of all vegetation is desired such as around buildings, storage areas, fences, pumps, machinery, fuel tanks, recreational areas, roadways, residential areas, guard rails, airports, military installations, highway medians, pipelines, railroads, lumberyards, and industrial sites (such as cross connects, pedestals, transformers, vaults, burred cable closures, telephone booths, and fire plugs). When applied to the soil, this product is intended to inhibit all plant growth for a year or more.

Following many years of continuous use of this product and chemically related products, biotypes of some of the weeds listed on this label have been reported which cannot be effectively controlled by this and related herbicides. Where this is known or suspected, we recommend the use of this product in combination with other registered herbicides which are not triazines. Consult with your State Agricultural Extension Service for specific recommendations.
