DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DIRECTIONS FOR DEMODECTIC MANGE: Dogs should be clipped and bathed if necessary, and thoroughly dried. Apply petrolatum or other bland ointment to eyes to prevent conjunctival irritation. Thoroughly massage CANEX Solution into and around infested areas. If animal is in poor physical condition, correct before applying CANEX. Apply to a small area to determine tolerance. Discontinue if gastrointestinal or other systemic complications occur. Demodectic mange is difficult to accurately diagnose and often requires prolonged treatment and attention to other factors such as diet. Apply daily for 7-10 days; if no improvement is noted after 10 days, consult veterinarian.

DIRECTIONS FOR EAR MITES: Dilute 1 part CANEX Solution with 3 parts of mineral oil. Shake well before using. Apply several drops in ear canal, massage to distribute over external ear structure. Repeat every 5 to 7 days for several applications, then as indicated.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep product in original container. Store in a cool, dry place preferably in a locked storage area out of reach of children or pets. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
