DIRECTIONS: Sprinkle freely over animal, working well into the hair. To prevent reinfestation, application should be made to the animal and its quarters, especially crevices, at weekly intervals as needed.

CAUTION

HUMAN — Harmful if inhaled or swallowed. Avoid breathing of dust. Avoid repeated contact with skin; wash thoroughly after using. Avoid contamination of food.

ANIMAL — Avoid contact with animal's eyes. Avoid treatment of kittens less than 4 weeks of age and nursing puppies. Repeated applications may produce skin or nasal irritation in sensitive animals — when this occurs DIRYL should be discontinued.

Do not reuse container. Destroy when empty.
