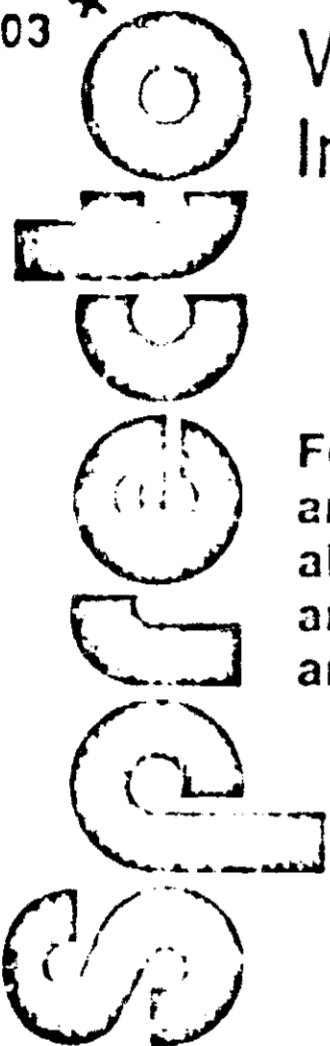

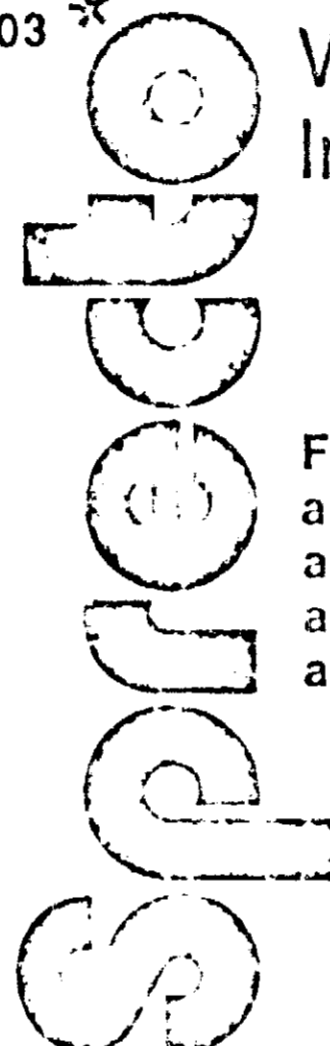

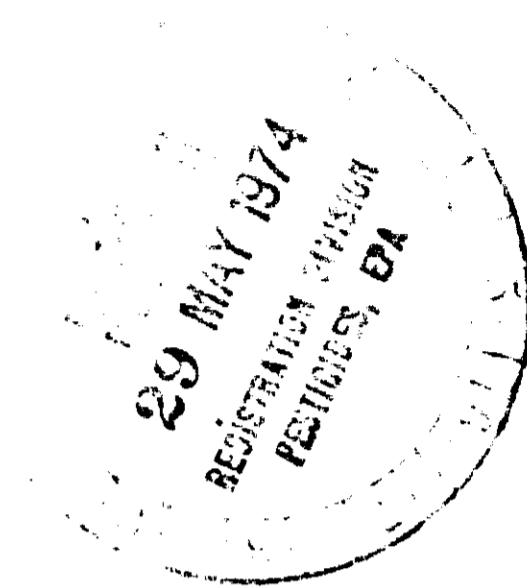

DIRECTIONS: Apply SPECTO with Repellent from a distance of 4 to 6 inches, protecting animal's eyes from spray.

Adult dogs: spray along the back from head to tail for light infestation. For heavy infestation entire hair coat should be slightly dampened. Ticks that are attached should be sprayed more heavily.

Adult cats: spray lightly on hair coat along the back from head to base of tail.

To prevent reinfestation, apply at weekly intervals as needed and spray head quarters thoroughly. Operates best at room temperature.
