SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Apply SPRECTO with Repellent from a distance of 4 to 6 inches, protecting animal's eyes from spray.

Adult dogs — spray along the back from head to tail for light infestation. For heavy infestation, entire hair coat should be slightly dampened. Ticks that are attached should be sprayed more heavily. Do not use on pregnant dogs.

Adult cats — spray lightly on hair coat along the back from head to base of tail.

To prevent reinfestation, apply at weekly intervals, as needed, and spray living quarters thoroughly. Operates best at room temperature.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame preferably in a locked storage area out of reach of children or pets. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard container in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate container.
