### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Weladol Disinfectant is a concentrate and must be diluted before using. Solutions should be freshly prepared and not used in combination with other cleaners or sanitizers.

1. As a sanitizer: 1 fluidounce Weladol Disinfectant to 5 gallons water (25 ppm. of iodine); for previously cleaned floors, walls, cages, glassware, utensils, dishes, etc.

2. As a cleanser and disinfectant: 3 fluidounces Weladol Disinfectant to 5 gallons water (75 ppm. of iodine); for cleaning and disinfecting in one operation. Scrub or mop thoroughly. Recommended for use in operating room, animal rooms, animal cages, lavatories, laboratories, and refuse areas. For surfaces difficult to clean, use 6 fluidounces Weladol Disinfectant to 5 gallons water.

3. As a disinfectant: 3 fluidounces Weladol Disinfectant to 5 gallons water; for thermometers, tubing, surgical and hospital instruments, rubber gloves, etc. Preclean, removing all foreign matter.

Dilutions for 18 cc. Dispensing Pump: 18 cc. to 1 gallon gives 75 ppm. of iodine; 18 cc. to 3 gallons gives 25 ppm. of iodine.

Diluted Weladol Disinfectant is a self indicator of germicidal activity. Activity persists as long as amber color is evident.

**PRECAUTIONS:** Avoid contact with eyes and skin. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water. If eye irritation persists, get medical attention. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

Note: This concentrate and its dilutions will discolor jewelry.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
