**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**WELADOL DISINFECTANT** is a concentrate and must be diluted before using. Solutions should be freshly prepared and not be used in combination with other cleaners or sanitizers. This product may be used only for disinfecting pre-cleaned, hard nonporous, inanimate environmental surfaces. Remove gross filth and heavy soil with a preliminary cleaning prior to application of **WELADOL DISINFECTANT**.

**GENERAL USE AS A DISINFECTANT:** Prepare 3 fluid ounces **WELADOL DISINFECTANT** to 5 gallons water (75ppm iodine) for disinfecting floors, walls, cages, laboratories, refuse areas, thermometers, tubing, surgical instruments, hospital instruments, rubber gloves and other nonfood contact surfaces such as laboratory glassware, utensils, dishes, etc.

Dilutions for 18cc. dispensing pump: 18cc. to 1 gallon gives 75 ppm of iodine.

Apply with cloth, sponge, mop, mechanical spray device or foaming apparatus to pre-cleaned hard, nonporous, inanimate surfaces making sure that all surfaces are wetted thoroughly. Allow surfaces to remain wet for 10 minutes. When completed rinse with clean water.

If the disinfectant solution becomes diluted or soiled by repeated use prepare a fresh solution. Also, a fresh solution should be prepared for each day's use.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
