Dear Ms. deBruin,

The amended labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended is acceptable, provided that you comply with the following conditions.

- 1. Make the following changes to the label.
- a. Near the top of the label correct the spelling of fumigates (the specific name of the fungus claimed to be controlled). This correction is required on both the bottle and the carton versions of the labels.
- b. In the carton version of the label correct the chamical name of the active ingredient (a "-" is needed before "propenyloxy").
- 2. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration may be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

For the control of Aspergillus organisms in cleaned poultry and turkey hatchery equipment prior to introduction of the eggs. Equipment would include empty hatcher cabinets, setters, coolers, storerooms, handling equipment, etc. CLINAFARM® EC will dramatically reduce the levels of infectious organisms and spores in treated areas. To make 1 gallon of 1:100 dilution, add 1.25 fl. oz. (36 mL) of CLINAFARM® EC to one gallon of clean water to provide an antifungal concentration of 0.15% active ingredient. Do not use product undiluted. To assure proper efficacy, the area or equipment to be treated should be clean and closed off from outside air currents before treatment. Ventilations ducts may be treated but fans must be shut off. Fog or spray area to be treated at the rate of ½ fl. oz. diluted product per 150 cu. ft. (1 mL per 10 cu. ft.). Fog or spray to ensure good contact with surface areas. Do not re-enter treatment areas for two hours.
