

FIGURE 1

Place male button onto pin until it projects through the tip.

FIGURE 2

Dip tag button into disinfectant solution.

FIGURE 3

Press female tag under the clip by depressing lever.

FIGURE 4

Apply through ear between second and third rib, halfway between ear tip and head.

For control of horn flies, attach one tag to each ear of each animal. Tags remain effective up to 5 months. For season-long control of Gulf Coast ticks and face flies and as an aid in control of lice, stable flies, and house flies, attach two tags per animal (one in each ear). Apply when flies first appear in spring. Replace as necessary. Apply with Allflex Tagging System.

FIRST AID

If on skin	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
If swallowed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to any unconscious person.
