Dear Mr. Pavelchak:

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3 (c)(5) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below.

- 1. Change the word "teed" to "feed" in your "Storage and Disposal" section.
- 2. Revise your "First Aid" section to read:

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

Submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. If you have any questions, please call Dr. William Sproat of my team at 703-308-8587.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This labeling must be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide application.

FIGURE 1 Place male button onto pin until it Dip tag button into disinfectant projects through the tip.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For optimum control and to minimize development of insect resistance, use two tags per animal (one in each ear). All animals in the herd should be tagged. Apply when flies first appear in spring. Replace as necessary. Apply with Allflex® Tagging System. Tags remain effective up to five months. Remove tags in fall.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wear rubber or non-permeable protective gloves when applying or removing tags. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handing and before eating, drinking or using tobacco. Certain individuals are known to have a special sensitivity to some pyrethroid insecticides. Such individuals on contact with the insecticide may experience a "tingling or burning" sensation around the face, arms, armpits and/or groin. If such sensitivity occurs, wash the affected area with mild soap and water, and to relieve the sensation apply a thin layer of an oil based ointment. The sensation generally dissipates within 18-24 hours, if not, call a physician.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: This product contains a cholinesterase inhibitor. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not add directly to water. Do not contaminate water by disposal of used tags. Use the product only as specified on the label.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or teed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in a cool place away from direct sunlight. Opened pouches containing ear tags should be resealed for storage.

Pesticide Disposal: Remove tags before slaughter. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
