


Apply To	Target Species	Dosage
Lactating and Non-Lactating Dairy Cattle, Beef Cattle, and Calves	Lice, Horn flies, Face flies, Aids in control of Horse flies, Stable flies, Mosquitoes, Black flies, and Ticks.	Apply 3 mL per 100 lbs body weight of animal up to a maximum of 30 mL for any one animal. Pour along back and down face.
Sheep	Sheep keds, Lice	Pour along back. Apply 1.5 mL per 50 lbs of body weight of animal up to a maximum of 18 mL for any one animal

For cattle and sheep, repeat treatment as needed but not more than once every 2 weeks.
