ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is extremely toxic to aquatic organisms, including fish and invertebrates. To protect the environment do not allow pesticide to enter or run off into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters, or surface waters. Applying this product in calm weather when rain is not predicted for the next 24 hours will help to ensure that wind or rain does not blow or wash pesticide off the treatment area.

Target Species: Lice, Horn flies, face flies. Aids in control of Horse flies, Stable flies, Mosquitoes, Black flies, and Ticks

Dosage: Apply 3 mL per 100 lbs body weight of animal up to a maximum of 30 mL for any one animal. Pour along back and down face.

Back Rubber Use: Mix 100 mL per gallon of #2 diesel oil or mineral oil. Keep rubbing device charged. Results improved by forced daily use.

Apply To: Lactating and Non-Lactating Dairy Goats

Dosage: Apply 1.5 mL per 50 lbs body weight of animal up to a maximum of 18 mL for any one animal. Pour along back and down face.

Apply To: Sheep

Target Species: Sheep keds, Lice

Dosage: Pour along back. Apply 1.5 mL per 50 lbs of body weight of animal, up to a maximum of 18 mL for any one animal.

For cattle, horses, sheep, and goats, repeat treatment as needed but not more than once every two weeks. For horses, do not saddle horse for 6 hours after application and refrain from washing down area of application. For optimum lice control, two treatments at 14-day intervals are recommended.
