PRIA Amendment to review submitted efficacy and Companion Animal Safety data to support the following proposed claims: "Flea efficacy demonstrated in global field studies," "Effectively controls fleas in the home environment," "demonstrated effectiveness with dogs with FAD," "May be used with Scalibor Protector Band" and speed of kill claims.

The labeling referred to above submitted in connection with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended is acceptable provided you make the following changes:

- Page 2: Under "Restrictions," bullet each restriction within the paragraph formatting so that they are easily distinguishable from one another.
- Page 2: Under "Restrictions," for each package size revise "Do not use on puppies under 8 weeks of age and weighing less than XX lbs" with "Do not use on dogs or puppies under 8 weeks of age and weighing less than XX lbs."
- Pages 4: as already noted in the amendment letter dated 12/14/11: revise the sentence that reads "Do not use on dog (male or female) intended for breeding, pregnant or nursing" to read "Do not use on dogs (male or female) intended for breeding, or on dogs that are pregnant or nursing."

The efficacy studies, MRIDs 48598301-05 submitted were reviewed and the findings were summarized in the efficacy memo dated 1/25/12 (A. Metzger). Based on the review, the only claims that are supported are "Effectively controls fleas on dogs in a home environment" and "Starts killing fleas in 8 hours."

The Companion Animal Safety Study submitted, MRID 48598305, was classified as unacceptable in the memo dated 1/9/12 (B.Backus) and the claim "May be used with Scalibor Protector Band" was not supported.




