



DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For cleaning: Shake well before using. Point button to mark on rim. Hold can 6 to 8 inches from surface to be cleaned. Press button and cover area lightly with white foam. After a few seconds, wipe off with clean cloth or sponge. For stubborn stains, allow foam to remain longer on surface before wiping.

For disinfecting, killing athlete's foot fungus, Influenza A₁ (Japan), Herpes Simplex Type 1 Virus and HIV-I (causative agent of AIDS) on hard non-porous surfaces: If surfaces are extremely dirty, follow cleaning directions first then spray on surface until thoroughly covered with foam. Leave for 10 minutes. Wipe with damp cloth or sponge.

For mold and mildew control on non-porous surfaces: To control mold and mildew, spray on surface until thoroughly covered with foam. Let stand 3 minutes. Wipe with damp cloth or sponge. Reapply as necessary.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: If in eyes, remove contact lenses, flush eyes with water for 15 minutes. If on skin, wash thoroughly with soap and water. Consult a physician if irritation occurs.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Contents under pressure. Do not puncture, use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperature above 120° F or in sun or discarding can in fire or incinerator may cause bursting.
