  - c. Place the signal word "Warning" immediately below the child hazard warning statement (front panel only).
  - d. Under the "For general cleaning, disinfecting and deodorizing" heading, delete the entire sentence beginning with "General Classification: It is a violation of Federal law . . . ."
  - e. Change "See back panel for additional precaution." to read "See back panel for additional precautionary statements."
  - f. Revise the statement "causes eye irritation" to read "causes eye and skin irritation."
2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.




