The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, to comply with the Agency's letter dated February 1, 1995, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling change listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended label.

1. On page 3 revise the statement "For disinfecting, killing athlete's foot fungus, Influenza A2 (Japan) ... on hard, nonporous surfaces: If surfaces are extremely dirty, follow cleaning directions first ..." to read "For disinfecting, killing Trichophyton mentagrophytes (athlete's foot fungi), Influenza A2/Japan/305/57... on hard, nonporous inanimate environmental surfaces: Remove gross filth or heavy soil prior to application of the product. If surfaces are extremely dirty, follow cleaning directions first ..."

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records. Submit five (5) copies of the final printed label prior to release of the product for shipment.

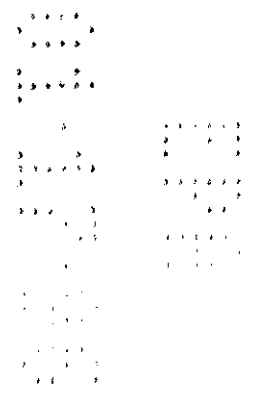

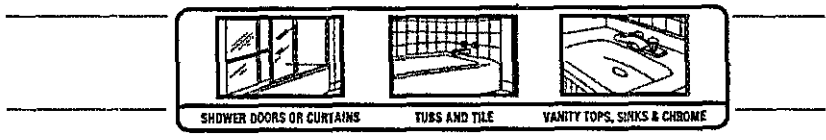

For disinfecting, killing athlete's foot fungus, Influenza A2 (Japan), Pseudomonas aeruginosa, Salmonella choleraesuis, dangerous staph and strep germs, Herpes Simplex Type 1 & 2 Viruses, Rhinovirus type 39, Rotavirus and Respiratory Syncytial Virus, on hard, nonporous surfaces: If surfaces are extremely dirty, follow cleaning directions first; then spray on (apply on) surface until thoroughly wet. Leave for 10 minutes. Wipe with damp cloth or sponge.
