The labeling referred to above submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act is acceptable provided that you make the following revisions before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. Place the statement "Keep Out of Reach of Children" immediately above the signal word "WARNING." Capitalize the first letter in "Out," "Reach," and "Children."
2. Include the word "non-porous" after "hard" in the statement "Use it to disinfect hard . . . buildings" on the blister card.
3. Note that "Statement of Practical Treatment"/"Practical Treatment" is preferred in place of "First Aid."

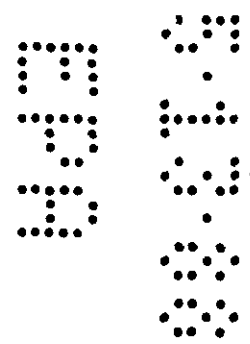

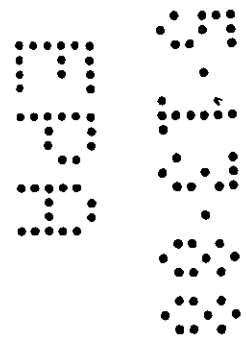

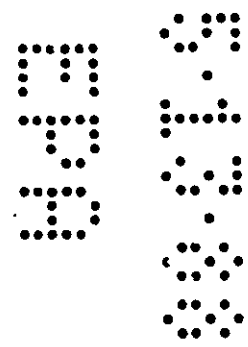
