For disinfecting, and general cleaning and deodorizing hard nonporous surfaces, and for laundry use.

The dual-action top provides the convenience of full-strength application for tough cleaning jobs, in combination with easy pouring into a bucket for large cleaning tasks.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. Pull up spout and squeeze bottle for full strength usage.
2. Remove Dual-Action top for easy pouring into a bucket.

HOUSEHOLD CLEANING/DEODORIZING: Use 1/4 cup per gallon water to clean floors, walls, cabinets, woodwork, sinks, tiles, chrome, garbage pails, or use full-strength inside toilet bowls, bathtubs and shower stalls, and for tough cleaning jobs on tile grout and grease. Rinsing required when used full strength, and on rubber or asphalt tile, and on food contact surfaces (or) No rinsing necessary except on rubber and asphalt tile. Rinse food contact surfaces with water.

Use full strength for cutting grease, old wax or other tough cleaning jobs; rinse immediately.

DISINFECTING: Kills household germs on hard, non-porous surfaces such as kitchen and bathroom floors, in toilets and diaper pails. Use 1/4 cup per gallon of water to kill Salmonella and odor causing bacteria. Use full strength to kill dangerous Staph germs. Apply with sponge or mop until surface is thoroughly wet, let stand 10 minutes, then remove excess. Rinsing required when used full strength. If surfaces are heavily soiled, follow cleaning directions first.

MOLD AND MILDEW PREVENTION: To prevent mold and mildew use full-strength on non-porous surfaces such as tiles and porcelain/fiberglass fixtures. Let soak 10 minutes. Rinse. Repeat application as needed.

LAUNDRY: Add 1/2 cup with regular soap or detergent. Use full-strength on stubborn stains and spots prior to washing. To control odor-causing bacteria in diapers, remove excess soil and then pre-soak in 1/2 cup per gallon of water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container in areas inaccessible to small children.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and put in trash.
