

For Use in Homes - Kills Household Germs, Including Staph in Bathroom Bowls.

Cleans, disinfects and deodorizes even under the rim. Thick liquid formula sticks to the bowl for better cleaning. Clings to the bowl to remove tough stains. Leaves a fresh clean fragrance (scent) (of pine). Safe for white and colored bowls. Harmless to (will not harm) plumbing and / or septic tanks. Contains no phosphorus.

Directions For Use: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read the entire label before using product.

TO OPEN CHILD RESISTANT CAP: Place bottle on flat, horizontal surface. Avoid squeezing bottle when opening. With one hand grasp bottle firmly near top. With other hand, while pushing cap down, turn cap counter-clockwise. Do not squeeze bottle. To reseal, twist cap until tightly locked.



TO DISINFECT AND CLEAN: Flush bowl and remove heavy soil by scrubbing with a stiff brush prior to application of (using) product. Raise toilet seat. Point top of bottle down into bowl. Squeeze gently, directing at least 4 oz. (squeeze approximately 15 seconds) of the thick liquid formula under the rim and on the sides of the bowl, letting it run down into the water. Let stand for at least 10 minutes, then brush entire bowl and flush. Rinse brush in fresh bowl water after each use.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: Hazards to humans and domestic animals.

DANGER: Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Harmful if swallowed. May produce chemical burns. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or clothing. Wear protective eyewear and rubber gloves when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Avoid contamination of food. Never use with chlorine bleach or any other chemical product.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If in eyes: Immediately flush eyes with water, remove any contact lenses and continue to flush eyes for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

If on skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. If irritation occurs, consult a physician.

If swallowed: Rinse mouth, drink one or two glasses of water. Do not induce vomiting. Call physician immediately.

Note to physician: Probably mucosal damage may contraindicate use of gastric lavage.
