For tuberculocidal activity, Lysol^R Brand Disinfectant Trigger Spray is effective in 10 minutes at 20°C. (68°F.) on a moderately soiled, nonporous surface. For heavily soiled surfaces, pre-clean prior to application of product.

To control mold and mildew and their odors: Clean surface prior to application. Spray surface until covered with mist. Repeat applications as necessary. For hard-to-reach surfaces, turn nozzle to stream position.

TO SANITIZE NON-FOOD CONTACT SURFACES: Hold container upright 6" to 8" from surface, spray surface until covered with mist. Allow to stand 30 seconds.
