

- e. Revise the statement "... great on modern washable surfaces such as fiberglass... and tile." to read "... for use on modern washable, hard nonporous surfaces such as fiberglass... and glass tile."
- f. Under the "Directions for Use" revise the phrase "... hard nonporous surfaces..." to read "... hard nonporous inanimate environmental surfaces..."
- g. Place the referral statement to appear directly below the signal word "CAUTION". These statements are considered separate label elements.
- h. Revise Net Wt to read: Net Contents.
