

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, to include the HIV-1 virus on the product label, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended label.

- Under the directions for disinfection, revise precleaning use directions to specify that "gross filth and heavy soil" must be removed prior to application of the product as a disinfectant-cleaner. For clarification or specifies, refer to item #3 of the DIS/TSS-15 enclosure.
- 2. On the back panel, the use directions for toilet bowls should be reposition and listed as a separate directions for use. Revise the read similar to this instruction "Toilet Bowls: Flush and then add 1-11/2 oz. full strength to the bowl water. thoroughly swab all bowl surfaces making sure to get under the rim. Let stand 10 minutes, then flush.
- Under the directions for ruse, the directions for mold and mildew control should be expanded and listed as a separate instructions such as: Mold and Mildew Control: Apply to hard nonporous surfaces (follow instructions for disinfection). Allow to dry on surface, repeat treatment at weekly intervals or when mildew growth returns.
- 4. On the back panel, middle of the page, revise "...and (household) germs on hard, nonporous surfaces..." to read "...and many (household) germs on hard, nonporous inanimate surfaces...".



A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records. Submit five (1) copies of the final printed label prior to release of the product for shipment.


