DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labelling.

Before spraying, vacuum area to be treated using a readily available 2-ply vacuum bag. Spray evenly to cover area and let air dry for approximately 15 minutes. Contents will treat approximately four mattresses. One month later, vacuum area again and respray. Continue to repeat treatment each month for continuous dust mite control. See can for full directions.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: <u>Hazards to humans and Domestic Animals</u>.

<u>Caution:</u> Causes eye irritation. <u>Avoid spraying in eyes</u>, on skin or on clothing.

First Aid: In case of eye contact, immediately flush eyes thoroughly with water, remove any contact lenses, and continue to flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
