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2. As per the Agency letter of 7/30/99 for 777-66 (item A) include as part of the "Ingredients Statement" the following phrase "Total.....100%".

3. As per the Agency letter of 7/30/99 for 777-66 (item H) revise the phrase "Kills 99.9% of germs in seconds on hard nonporous surfaces*" by deleting the word "germs" and replacing it with the word "bacteria". Your label is referring to your sanitization claim for killing *bacteria* in "30 seconds" not fungi, viruses, and bacteria as the term "germs" implies.

4. Revise the phrase near the top of the back panel exactly as follows to agree with the terminology considered acceptable by the Agency "Kills bacteria such as *Salmonella choleraesuis* (*Salmonella*), *Escherichia coli* (*E. Coli*), *Campylobacter jejuni*, and *Listeria monocytogenes* (*Listeria*).". The full name (genus and species must be listed with any abbreviation following in parenthesis.)

5. To bring this label into agreement with the label of 777-66, add the following statement to the directions for "General Household Cleaning": "Not recommended for use on acrylic plastics, finished wood surfaces, marble, or brass."

6. Add the following two statements to the sections which begins "For heavily soiled surfaces...": "This product is not for use on cookware, glasses, or eating utensils. After use to sanitize or disinfect food contact surfaces, rinse with potable water."

7. Revise the statement in the middle of the back panel as follows: "Kills 99.9% of *Salmonella choleraesuis* (*Salmonella*), *Escherichia coli* (*E. Coli*), *Staphylococcus aureus* (*staphylococcus*), *Streptococcus pyogenes* (*streptococcus*) in 30 seconds."

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.


