4. On page 2, change "keeps water crystal clear" to "keeps water clear" as this implies heightened efficacy.
5. On page 2, delete "continuous anti-bacterial action" and "continuously kills 99.9% of bacteria" as this contradicts the 8 week claims elsewhere.
6. On page 2, delete "kills bathroom bacteria" and "kills common household bacteria" as these claims are too broad and inappropriate for a toilet bowl water product.

Submit one copy of the final printed label prior to releasing this product for sale. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

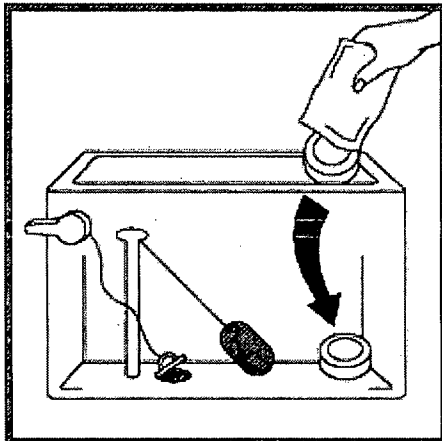
