Product must be used in a toilet that is flushed regularly.


To Clean / Deodorize & Sanitize:

1. Clean toilet bowl thoroughly (including under the rim).

2. Remove toilet tank top. Cut pouch open with scissors on dotted lines. Do not touch tablet.

3. Flush toilet. Before tank refills, drop tablet into (tank near sidewall closest to the float and away from the water valve opening) (right rear corner of the tank) (See graphic). Wash hands thoroughly.

4. When tablet has dissolved, replace with a new tablet. Each tablet sanitizes for 8 weeks.

	FIRST AID

If on Skin or Clothing	 Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.
If swallowed	 Call a Poison Control Center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the Poison Control Center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
