# SENTRY® CAT COLLAR

**CAUTION:** Do not allow children to play with this collar—see cautions on back.

Contents: 1 collar—2/5 ounce net weight

**DIRECTIONS:** Buckle collar securely but not tightly around cat's neck. **COLLAR MUST BE WORN LOOSELY.** Cut off and dispose of any excess length. Collar will start killing fleas on cat immediately. New fleas temporarily appearing will be killed during the three months collar is worn. Remove if cat is bathed. Excessive exposure to water reduces effectiveness. Replace when effectiveness diminishes.

They are also unpredictably sensitive to many chemicals. In such cases (or if collar is too tight) a neck irritation may result. When collar is first worn, observe neck area for irritation every few days. Remove collar if there is evidence of irritation and permit area to heal. For use on cats only. Do not use on sick or convalescing cats. Do not use any other pesticide on cat while collar is worn.
